MMM has established itself as the National Forum for research scientists, diagnostic laboratory staff and clinicians to share the latest issues and technological developments in the field of molecular microbiology, in an informal workshop setting. MMM recognises that companies play a major role in the development of the diagnostic field and invite Exhibitors to give a 10-minute oral presentation in the main program describing recent research. In order to fit this in the program alongside talks by scientists and clinicians it needs to have a research title and include research performed by the company or in conjunction with its customers. A useful guide is that the title of the talk should not name a product or indeed the company. Acceptable Title: "NGS identifies new species of X". However, "<The Company> NGS instrument" places itself outside the scientific sessions.

MMM 2016 is a two-day meeting, with an informal workshop style that encourages comments and questions from the floor. A/Professor Randall Olsen - Application of NGS in the Clinical Laboratory

Houston Methodist Research Institute | Houston Methodist Hospital | Weill Cornell Medical College, Cornell University (*Keynote*)

The research in the Olsen laboratory is focused on studying the molecular pathogenesis of invasive group A Streptococcus (GAS) infections such as necrotizing fasciitis (NF, also termed the flesh eating infection)

Professor Stephen Baker - Enteric infections

Nuffield Department of Medicine, University of Oxford / Wellcome Trust Major overseas programme (WT-MOP), Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam (*Keynote*)

The Baker group studies the microbiology, genetics, epidemiology and treatment of enteric infections in developing countries. Focal pathogens include Norovirus, Shigella spp. and Salmonella Typhi, the causative agents of diarrhea, dysentery and typhoid fever, respectively.
